Hackers threaten to leak data of Intel, AMD in Gigabyte attack

New Delhi, Taiwanese hardware company Gigabyte has reportedly suffered a cyber breach, and the hackers are threatening to release more than 112 GB of data that may include confidential documents from chip makers Intel and AMD and American firm Megatrends. According to a report in The Record, the RansomExx ransomware gang has hit Gigabyte. "A spokesperson said the incident did not impact production systems. Only a few internal servers at its Taiwanese headquarters have been affected and

have now been taken down and isolated," the report said. The Taiwanese company is known for its high performance motherboards. The message on RansomExx extortion page hosted on a dark web portal reads: "We have downloaded 112 GB (120,971,743,713 bytes) of your files and we are ready to PUBLISH it. Many of them are under NDA (Intel, AMD, American Megatrends)." The company was investigating how the hackers breached its systems, stole files, and encrypted local copies.—IANS

Adani Group likely to take over Guwahati airport in October

Guwahati/Itanagar, The Adani Group on Monday began its "Observation Period" at the Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International (LGBI) airport in Guwahati as part of its mandate to develop and modernise northeast India's main airport, officials said. An Airport Authority of India (AAI) official said that a nine-member team of the Adani Airport Holding Ltd (AAHL) led by Chief Airport Officer Utpal Baruah, an aviation industry expert who also hails from Assam, on Monday formally started its "Observation Period" and is likely to take over charge in October.

An AAI official on condition of anonymity said that as per the agreement with the Centre, existing AAI personnel would support the company for a period of three years. Land near the airport

der the Public Private Partnership (PPP) model. "The Centre took the decision to enhance the revenue of the AAI and augment the economic development in these areas in terms of job creation and related infrastructure," the AAI official told IANS. The Adani group had emerged as the successful bidder for all the six air-

ports. Meanwhile, Arunachal Chief Minister Pema Khandu called on Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya M. Scindia in New Delhi and discussed various issues pertaining to the state's airports. An official of the Chief Minister's Office on Monday said that Khandu requested Scindia to consider development of Advance Landing Grounds in the state's airports. "Besides

pleading for conducting a feasibility inspection of ALG Tuting and Mechuka for fixed wing operation, the CM reiterated for starting of fixed wing flight operation at Pasighat and Tezu airports on priority basis," the official said.

Musk-run SpaceX acquires satellite startup Swarm Technologies

San Francisco, SpaceX is acquiring satellite connectivity startup Swarm Technologies for an undisclosed sum, its first acquisition in the 19 years of its existence. Swarm raised \$25 million in August 2018 and launched its flagship product called the Tile which is a small modem that can be embedded in various connectivity devices and linked to the satellite network. Swarm operates a constellation of 120 sandwich-sized satellites as well as a ground station network, reports TechCrunch. "The deal would transfer control of Swarm's ground and space licenses to SpaceX, in addition to any licenses pending before the commission," the report said on Monday. "Swarm's services will benefit from the better capitalisation and access to

resources available to SpaceX, as well as the synergies associated with acquisition by a provider of satellite design, manufacture, and launch services," the companies said in a filing in the US. SpaceX would "similarly benefit from access to the intellectual property and expertise developed by the Swarm team, as well as from adding this resourceful and effective team to SpaceX." SpaceX's Starship last week officially become the world's tallest rocket. At around 395 feet tall, the spacecraft is the tallest in the world. NASA has awarded SpaceX its Human Landing System contract for a version of Starship to land astronauts on the lunar surface as part of its Artemis programme.
